kaldor suggest but rather it originates importantly from the rules of the game which have weakened the bargaining power of workers as they have increased the market power of corporations he also explains how monetary authorities have contributed to increasing wealth inequality and how unless something is done about it likely changes in technology such as ai and robotization will make matters worse he describes policies that can simultaneously reduce inequality and improve economic performance
